Set a "love jar" on the kitchen counter. When your children see an act of kindness or God's love demonstrated, help them write it down and place the note in the jar. At the end of the month, go out for ice cream and take time to read the pile of slips. You may need to begin the month by pointing out to your little ones moments when someone is showing love. You may say something like, "Did you see the way that man held the door open for others as they were walking into the restaurant? He was showing love."
