Example: Thank you God for this beautiful blue sky and the birds that I see flying!

Ideas to Live It Out:

- Read Genesis 1 from the Bible or read the creation story from a children's storybook Bible.
- Take a walk and point out things that God made. Take a bag with you and pick up interesting leaves, flowers, rocks. Remind your child that God created each of these things.
- Make a collage of leaves and flowers that you collect, or put the items in a jar and place it somewhere you will see it often. When you see the jar, practice quoting the memory verse with your child.
- Make up a song or motions together to learn Genesis 1:1
