

What is a Disciple?

A disciple is a follower of Jesus Christ.

What is Discipleship?

Discipleship is described in the Bible as the process of *Sanctification* and is the ordained, supernatural process of spiritual formation that leads to Christ-likeness.

What are the Characteristics of a Disciple?

- A disciple knows Jesus Christ as Savior (The Head).
- A disciple follows Jesus Christ as Lord (The Heart).
- A disciple is being *transformed* and *conformed* into the image of Jesus Christ (The Will).
 - A disciple is actively *participating* in the mission and ministries of the church (The Hands).
- A disciple is *bearing fruit* in their life and in their relationships (The Character).

Admit that you are a sinner.

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

Romans 3:23

We all have sins in our hearts. We all were born with sin. We were born under the power of sin's control.

"Wherefore, as by one man sin entered the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned."

Romans 5:12

Our sin was handed down from our parents. Every person that was born after Adam (who was disobedient in the Garden of Eden) has been born a sinner (Genesis 3).

Understand that you deserve death for your sin.

"The wages of sin is death..."

Romans 6:23a

We all face physical death, which is a result of sin. But a worse death is spiritual death that separates us from God, and will last for all eternity. The Bible teaches that there is a place called the Lake of Fire where those who reject Christ will be in torment forever (Revelation 20:15).

Understand that we cannot do anything to earn our way to heaven.

"...But the <u>gift of God</u> is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." **Romans 6:23b**

Salvation is a free gift from God to you! You can't earn this gift; you must reach out and receive it.

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: <u>it is the gift of God</u>: Not of works, lest any man should boast." **Ephesians 2:8-9**

Understand that God has already made a way for your forgiveness.

"But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, <u>Christ died for us.</u>" **Romans 5:8**

When Jesus died on the cross, He paid sin's penalty. He paid the price for all sin. The only condition is that we believe in Him and what He has done for us.

Understand that we must respond to what God has already done.

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." "Whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

His love poured out in Jesus on the cross is your only hope to have forgiveness and change. His love is what saves you, not any kind of religious work or being good enough. God loves you just the way you are, He just doesn't want you to stay that way!

If you are ready to make this commitment, pray this prayer.

Dear Lord Jesus,

I know that I am a sinner and I believe that you died for my sins on the cross. I believe that you were buried and that you rose again from the grave. 
